





There has been much discussion around the LETS world about whether there should be widespread business involvement in LETSystems. Many people blame businesses for the problems we are experiencing now and believe they should be treated like the plague, which has a degree of sense. However the reality is that it is business that employs people and the taxes we all then pay goes to running the government, employing public servants and running programs we as communities want. We may not like it, but right now almost all economic activity is generated by businesses.


The proposition that businesses should not participate in LETS is interesting. Basically it is saying that if we are dollar poor then we should remain dollar poor - there appears to be some kind of saintliness in poverty. If LETS doesn't allow widespread business participation then we will continue to spend all our dollars on basic needs and our LETS currency on sidelines or labour, and those of us who are poor will remain so. If we encourage business membership then we will be able to spend 10 - 25% of our needs as LET\$ and have the Federal \$ to spend on other things. We will be financially better off. Not only that but the businesses will have to spend their LETS income. They can spend some on materials and


goods but will spend most on labour. It will mean that people will be employed, even casually or part time, which seems to be a whole lot better than people staying home watching midday TV. These wages will consist of a combination of both LET\$ and Federal \$, making us even better off.

The use of LETS currency will also enable fledgling or environment based businesses to make their Federal \$ go further, which will enhance the possibility for success, creating more employment. The interesting here is that people will be able to start doing socially constructive work, which isn't affordable at present, instead of destructive work, which is often the case now.

LETS may or may not work without business involvement, however it is unquestionable that we will all have a much greater commitment to making LETS work if there is widespread business involvement, it will be our interest. So assume that a socially reprehensible company joins LETS. Who is obliged to trade with them? No one. If the same company wants to employ people for all Barts say - "no, we don't want or have to trade with you". Business participation does not mean we have to change what we are doing now, it will simply enable us to do it differently and better.


