Dear Graeme,

Thank you for your time in meeting with NEFA representatives in Coffs Harbour on 2nd November 1992, and I apologise for the short notice given about the following matters. I will endeavour to ensure that an agenda is provided to you prior to our next meeting in order to facilitate better information exchange. I would also like to confirm that you gave an undertaking that the following information would be supplied to NEFA:-

1. **Wild Cattle Creek SF:** The Commission agreed to investigate and advise NEFA about the possibility of exchanging data with NEFA for the area outlined on the accompanying map. The agreement would involve Commission providing digital information on forest types in exchange for NEFA's digital information on growth stage development. This information would be used to provide an example of how an assessment of old growth forest can be undertaken. Forest type and growth stage development information would remain the property of the Commission and NEFA respectively.
2. **Stockyard Ck, Chaelundi SF:** The Commission's Management Audit Review Unit report on breaches in this area will be forwarded to Dailan Pugh by 5/11/92.
3. **Mt Killiekrankie, Oakes SF:** The Commission will request the Soil Conservation Service to provide a copy of their report urgently. A copy of this report will be forwarded when it becomes available. We would like to also formally request that a copy of the report prepared by the Commission's own consultant is forwarded at the same time. If this request is refused we request that the reasons are given in writing when the SCS report is forwarded.

4. **Wingham EIS:** The Commission agreed to provide a copy of the Glen Innes Fauna Impact Statement referred to in the Wingham EIS today. The Commission further agreed that all unpublished reports and documents referred to in future EIS will be publicly available during the exhibition period at the relevant District Offices, and preferably also Regional Office.

5. **Washpool and Billilmbra SF:** The Commission will arrange to allow Dallan Pugh to accompany an inspection of the regeneration and rehabilitation project in early December. The Commission will prepare a report on the progress of this project, its compliance with the terms of agreement and the Commission's continuing commitment to the project. This report will be forwarded well in advance of the above inspection. The Commission further agreed to investigate and report on the numerous incidents of non-compliance with Commission prescriptions that caused the need for the above project.

6. **Desert Ck, Washpool SF:** The Commission agreed to report on the status of the identified aboriginal sites and describe the measures that have been to protect them as an Aboriginal Area, either under the National Parks and Wildlife Act or under the Forestry Act. We would also like to know what discussions have been held with the local aboriginal community, and what action has been undertaken, to repair damage that has occurred to sites as a result of previous roading activities.

7. **Timber Industry Conference, Coffs Harbour:** The Commission agreed to provide a copy of the resolutions made at the above conference.

8. **Marketing Strategy and Log Deregulation:** The Commission agreed to provide all information on the above matter that has been given to the timber industry, and will incorporate our comments as appropriate.

9. **Draft EIS Consultant Briefs:** The Commission agreed to consider to circulate draft consultant briefs for public comment for the Environmental Impact Statements that are to be prepared for Walcha - Armidale, Urbenville and Coffs Harbour - Urunga Management Areas. We would appreciate a response on this matter as soon as possible.

If you have any queries with the above matters would you please forward your comments as soon as possible so that any misunderstanding may be clarified at the earliest opportunity,
