

Lot's of people cannot attend direct actions, go to forest protests, get arrested or spend months in court. Those at the front line of forest protection often take serious risks to achieve major gains - but they can also get themselves into debt. Those who can't take these risks can help out.

For example, our friend John Corkill from the North East Forest Alliance (NEFA) took the timber workers union to court for their threats of violence during a forest protest in December 1995 and has consequently incurred legal debts of several thousand dollars. Application for the cancellation of the registration of the Construction Forestry Mining and Energy Union

I am the Applicant in this matter.

On 7 March 1996 Mr Justice Wilcox awarded costs against me on a limited basis only.

I have the following objections to the Bill of Costs filed with the Court on 30 May 1996, by Mr Masselos on behalf of the CFMEU.

The Bill includes costs not ordered against me by His Honour. Wilcox J expressly declined to order the costs of Mr Hillier against me, when requested to do so by Mr Nolan. I recall His Honour expressly stating that the costs awarded were "for the Union's costs for that day's hearing".

Since paragraph 3 of Mr Masselos's advice in his Bill of Costs states this, I am at a loss to know why Mr Masselos has included costs which pre-date the formal joining of the Union on 18 January 1996 or Mr Masselos serving on me of a Notice of Appearance on behalf of the CFMEU on 19 February 1996. It was 21 February 1996 when Mr Masselos filed his Notice of Motion to have the matter dismissed, and it was this motion which was heard and agreed to by His Honour on 7 March 1996.

Costs associated with earlier hearings on 2nd February were not the Union's, since Mr Nolan insisted in his appearance before Wilcox CJ on that day that he was not instructed by the Union. This refusal by Mr Nolan to seek instructions from the Union, despite the direct request of HH, led to a further hearing being required on 7 March, by which time the CFMEU had filed a Notice of Motion to dismiss the matter.

Mr Masselos claims to have been instructed by the CFMEU from 24 January 1996 and to have attended Court on 2 February, yet he did not approach the Bench when His Honour sought to resolve the matter on that day and specifically sought an appearance by the CFMEU. Even more strangely, the Bill of Costs includes Mr Nolan's fees for his appearance on 2 February, the very day he told HH that he was not instructed by the CFMEU but by Mr Hillier.

I object to being billed for all the costs claimed by Mr Masselos on the basis that most of these are not costs incurred by the Union, but by Mr Hillier, or they are not costs associated with that day's (7 March) hearing.

I also object to the claim of some \$300.00 for general care & conduct. I do not understand what these costs represent, but Mr Masselos repeatedly misspells my surname despite me writing and requesting he note the correction. I was billed by Mr Masselos, for his time to read & file my letter (which I also object to), then further errors occur!

I especially object to the claiming of costs incurred after the hearing and the award of costs for that day's hearing. There could be no end to this!



- 1. In this matter the solicitors received instructions to act for the Construction Forestry Mining and Energy Union, the First Respondent to oppose an application by the Applicant to de-register the Union, and other orders.
- 2. The Application made by the Applicant, a "public interest" advocate, was based on complaints as to threats alleged to have been made by CFMEU officials to commit acts of violence on members of the public exercising their rights by protesting in forest disputes.
- 3. The Application as initially filed on 6 December, 1995 had sought the Orders against Mr Hillier, but the Application was subsequently amended in accordance with Directions made 20 December, 1995 to add the Union as First Respondent. In accordance with the costs orders of 7 March, 1996, costs in this Bill relate only to the costs of the Construction Forestry Mining and Energy Union, and not to the costs of Gavin Hillier.
- 4. On receipt of the Amended Application joining the Union as First Respondent on 24/1/96, and perusal of that application together with the other documents served by the Applicant with the Amended Application, including a detailed and lengthy affidavit by the Applicant, the solicitor prepared a Motion and affidavit in support on 21/2/96 seeking orders that the application be dismissed and that the Respondent's legal costs be paid by the Applicant. The Motion was based on the Respondent's contention that the application disclosed basis under s.294 of the Industrial Relations Act 1988 for the de-registration of the CFMEU.
- 5. The respondent's motion was heard on 7/3/96, when Wilcox CJ ordered that the Motion be dismissed and the Applicant pay the costs of the Construction Forestry Mining and Energy Union.
- 6. The solicitor with the conduct of the matter was Mr Masselos, the principal of the firm.
