The aims and objectives of the Pan-Community Council;

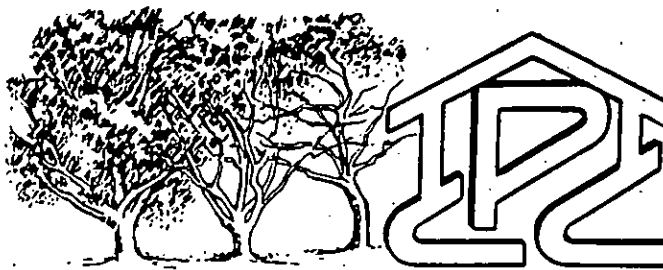
1. Protection of the natural environment.
