INDEX to IRVINE ARCHIVE TAPES

Introduction

List of Tape Interviews made by Graham Irvine in the *Rainbow Region* of Northern NSW between 1985 and 1991.

The accompanying list consists of 32 reel-to-reel tapes and 117, 60 and 90 minute cassette tapes recorded on a broadcast quality "Marantz" CP 230 audio cassette recorder.

Most of the tapes comprise interviews for the ABC radio programme *Practicalities* with others recorded for the Lismore community radio station 2NCR-FM etc. Some of Irvine's edited material has been published in an ABC two-volume book titled "**Practicalities**".

The material used by the ABC consists of either the original field recordings or an edited version of the field recordings. The subject topics for these interviews were selected by Graham Irvine.

The tapes were mostly recorded in the field, at various localities throughout the NSW Northern Rivers Region.

Graham Irvine is the copyright owner of all the field recordings listed in this Index.

At the time of making the field tapes, a brief description on the subject matter was noted on the tape label and orally noted in the "identification" recorded at the beginning of the interview. The field tapes were not numbered chronologically at the time of recording but have been subsequently numbered in an approximate chronological order. This has resulted in the present numerical list not coinciding with a calendar date order.

Further to our phone conversation on 26.5.03 please find enclosed the following: _

- 1(a) Letter to Mark Cranfield dated 30.6.02 together with "Index to Irvine tapes" and tape list (containing both cassette tapes and reel-to-reel tapes). We would appreciate your delivering this to Mark by hand.

2. For your information Graham is a long time friend of mine, both of us having attended the Aquarius Festival in 1973. Since then we have both been involved in the so called "New Settler Movement". Graham is a middle age man who last year was medically diagnosed as having Alzheimers disease and Sleep Apnia. These have had a dramatic impact on his health. While he has been on prescribed medication he views that it has not made any impact on his condition. One of the symptoms he experiences is a non communication between his brain and handwriting with the result that his writing involuntarily becomes smaller and smaller to the point where it is virtually unintelligible. This of course is a great handicap. (1)

His general carriage is deteriorating such that unless there is a marked improvement, the progenies for the future is not the best.

Feel free to pass on this information to Mark if you see fit, with the request to treat this information with discretion.

ABC RADIO NATIONAL LOOKS AT CASINO HISTORY

Hindsight, the social history program on ABC Radio National will broadcast a documentary about the Dutch Internment camp at Casino during and after the Second World War.

Casino in Northern NSW was the unlikely setting for the first strike by Indonesians against Dutch colonialism after the Second World War.

They were being trained to work in the oil industry by the Dutch East Indies Army, who were awaiting their triumphal return after the war to Indonesia.

They were free to come and go from the camp and locals remember socialising with the Indonesians and Dutch at the cinema and around the town. They also talk about concerts with Indonesian music and food that were held at the camp.

Not all the locals were happy though, there were some street fights over women and alcohol. Both the Dutch and Indonesians also sold things on the black market, like cigarettes, alcohol and clothes. The internees and troops were also banned from visiting South Casino to stop them mixing with the local Aboriginal population.

However when the Japanese were defeated and then Indonesia was declared independent in August 1945 the internees in Casino refused to work for the Dutch. They went on strike and as a result they were put behind barbed wire and two of them were shot.

Local Casino residents remember being surprised to see the guard towers and fencing go up overnight. Some of them felt very sorry for the Indonesians who were living in crowded conditions. Local trade unionists lobbied for better conditions and their release, they graffitied the town with slogans like "Australia's Belsen" and "Dutch Murderers".

When they were eventually repatriated to Indonesia at the end of 1946 they left behind in Casino a few broken hearts, a few wealthier shopkeepers and a town who'd had a taste of South East Asia in the days of the White Australia Policy.

The program also includes a song that was written by a local Casino man called "When They Send The Last Javos Home".

The program is on Sunday Nov 10th at 2:05pm, then repeated Thursday Nov 14th at 1:05pm. Radio National is on 96.9 FM. You will also be able to hear it on the web for 4 weeks afterwards by going to www.abc.net.au/rn and following the prompts to Hindsight.
