

## Tallow Creek study completed

The Department of Sustainable Natural Resources has announced the completion of a study of flooding in the Tallow Creek catchment.

The Regional Director of the Department of Sustainable Natural Resources, Des Schroder said that this study has provided information on the flood behaviour of Tallow Creek. The study was completed in November 2002 and has produced informa-

tion on flood flows, velocities, levels, hazards and the extents for a full range of flood events under existing catchment and floodplain conditions. The next stage will be a Tallow Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan which will be prepared by Sinclair Knight and Merz who were successful in gaining this contract. It is expected to be completed in late 2004.
